
ENR 1.5 HOLDING, APPROACH AND DEPARTURE PROCEDURES**1. GENERAL**

1.1 Instrument Approach Procedures (IAP) and relevant minima for Danish military airbases are established in accordance with the "CRITERIA FOR PREPARATION OF INSTRUMENT APPROACH AND DEPARTURE PROCEDURES, APATC-1 (A)". (TERPS)

1.2 Some IAP's for military airbases have been established for the use by civil air traffic and published by the Danish Civil Aviation authority in AIP Denmark. These procedures are established in accordance with ICAO DOC 8168 vol II (PANS OPS).

1.3 Holding procedures are established in accordance with FAA Handbook 7130.3 which is adopted by Danish military authorities.

1.4 Standard Instrument Departures (SID) are not published for Danish airbases.

2. CRITERIA TRANSITION PHASE

2.1 Denmark has ratified STANAG 3759 which implements ICAO PANS OPS - as described in ICAO doc 8168 – as a NATO standard. With STANAG 3759 the document AATCP-1 has been developed as a military supplement to PANS OPS, covering specific military procedures not addressed in ICAO doc 8168. Denmark is in a transition phase and all procedures will be re-calculated, starting approx. 2nd quarter 2009. All procedures will be clearly marked in the header to indicate on which criteria the procedure is calculated. (TERPS or PANS OPS)
